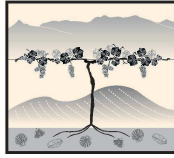

LIME ROCK SAUVIGNON BLANC 2009

100% LIME ROCK Central Hawke's Bay Sauvignon Blanc, grown on limestone hills, is from a single vineyard and hand picked.

2009 season

An excellent year. The 2009 autumn was warm and dry with ideal ripening conditions, right through to hand picking of grapes.

Our Sauvignon Blanc is grown on 3 blocks within our vineyard;

- C block is high on top (a flat area with the magnificent views)
- J block is on the north facing slopes, to the east
- G block is a flat area by the road.

These different blocks give a range of flavours and these vary from year to year.

Winemaking

The whole bunches were pressed, juice was settled, racked and inoculated. The cool ferment in stainless steel helped to retain the fragrant fruit characters. A short maturation on lees with stirring contributed to texture and length in the mouth.

Gooseberry, passionfruit, lychee and lime aromas and flavours feature in this LIME ROCK 2009 Sauvignon Blanc. The wine has surprising richness, soft acid with flavour and minerality that persists.
